Our last stop is Bartram's Garden, America's oldest living botanical garden featuring an 18th century farmstead, native plants,

Enjoy all the spectacular displays which range from elaborate landscapes to individual and club entries of prize horticultural specimens. Don't miss the fabulous market place with over 150 vendors. Monday, March 7

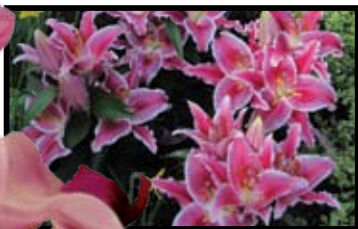
